

Nepal's Climate Finance Landscape: Multilateral Development Banks (MDBs) Financing 2013–2023

Multilateral Development Banks (MDBs) allocated and committed USD 3,165.6 million for Nepal in climate finance between 2013 and 2023, with over half provided by the World Bank, 54% directed to adaptation, and nearly four-fifths delivered through concessional loans.

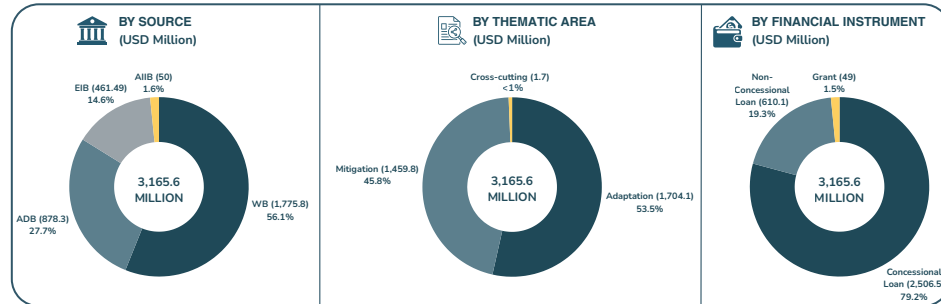

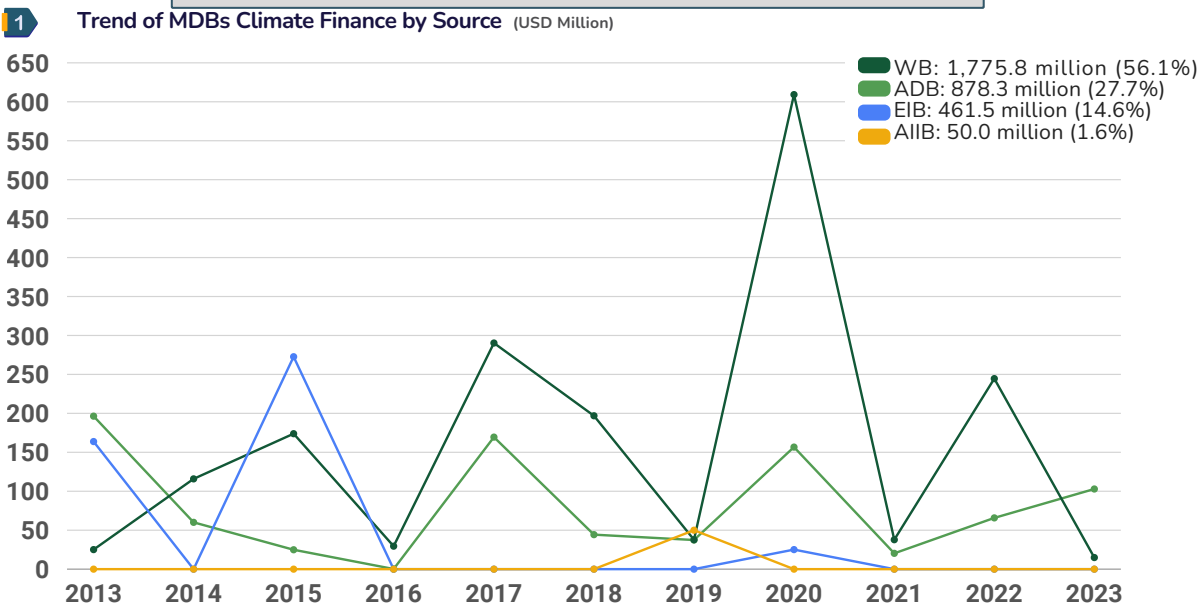

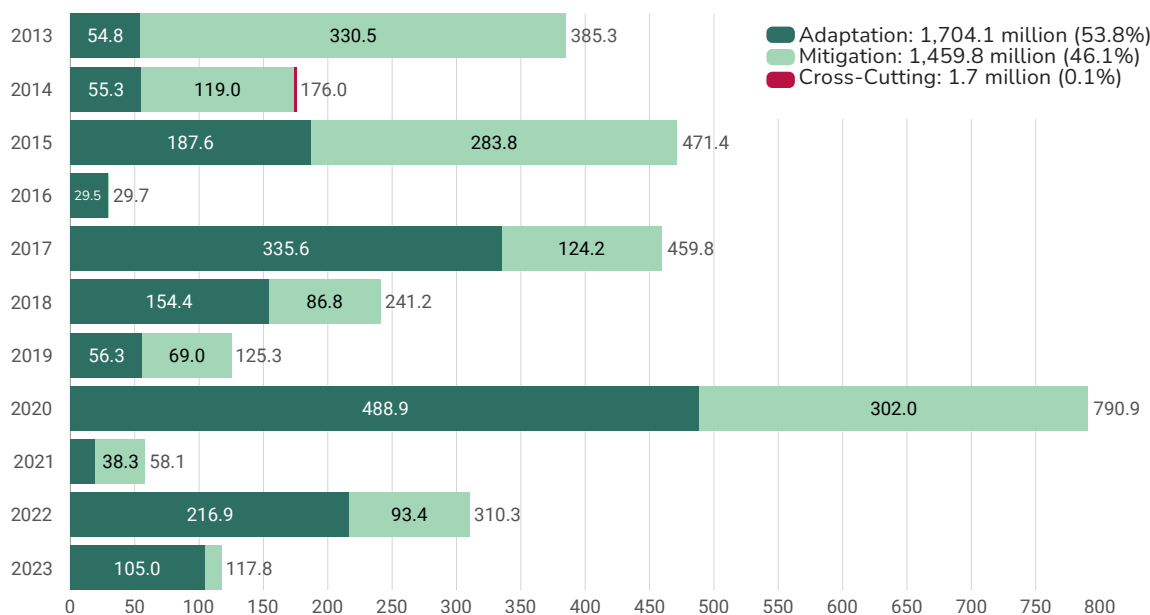
► Distribution of MDBs Financing by Source, Thematic area & Financial Instrument



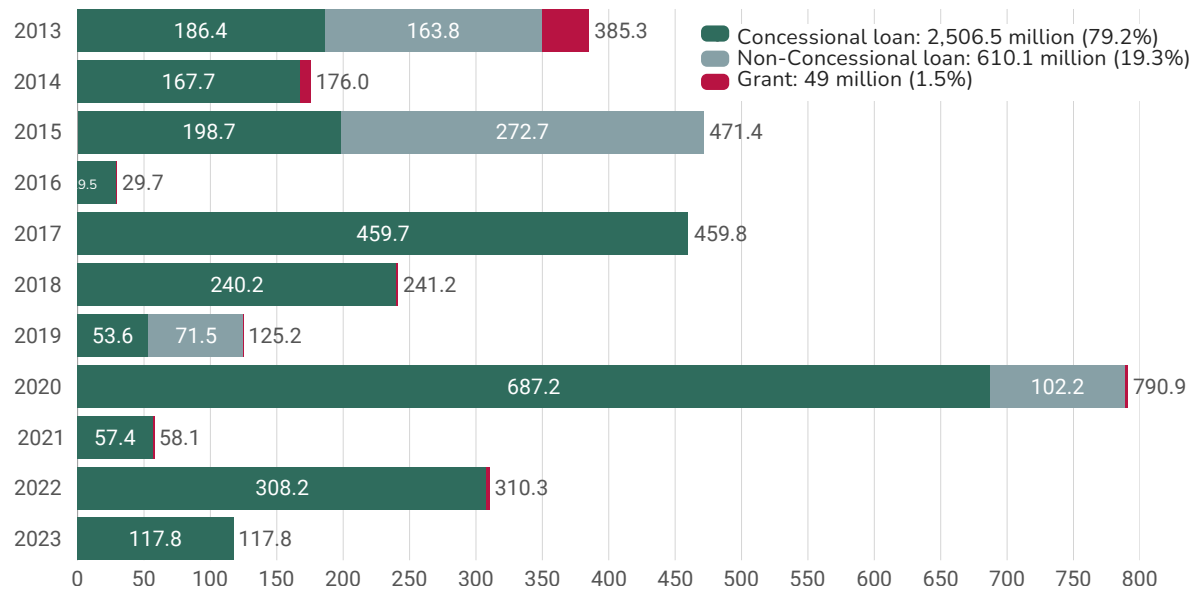
Trend of MDBs Financing by Source, Thematic Area & Financial Instrument



2 Trend of MDBs Climate Finance by Thematic Area (USD Million)

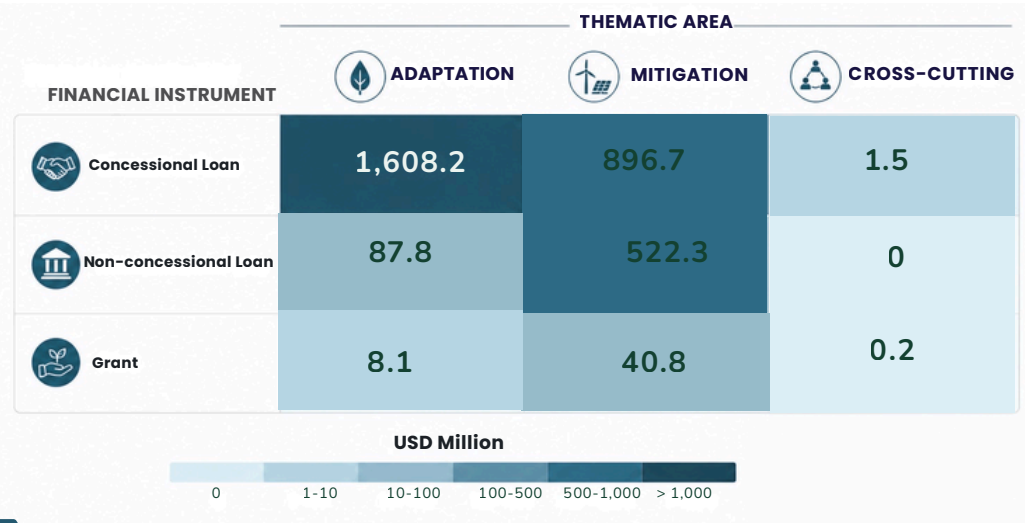


3 Trend of MDBs Climate Finance by Financial Instrument (USD Million)

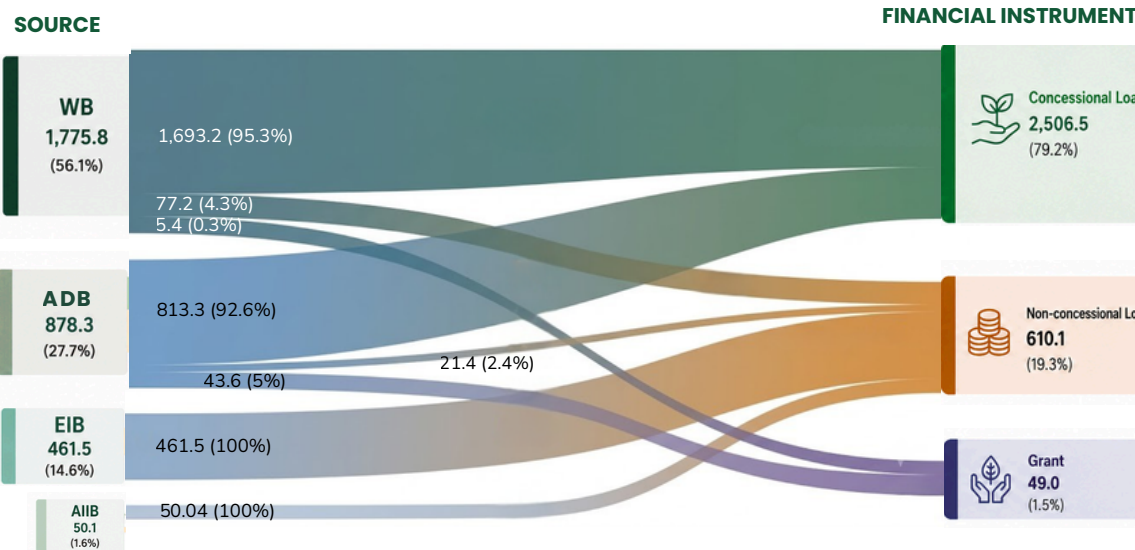
